Habitat operates three climate resiliency programs; weatherization, electrification and solar. These programs are aimed at helping income qualified homeowners in Montgomery County reduce energy costs and usage, improve indoor air quality and home comfort while ensuring a more sustainable future.



Potential Services

- · Air sealing
- Insulating attics, crawlspaces, and basements
- · Replacing & electrifying water heaters
- Adding ventilation (exhaust fans)
- · Replacing & repairing roofs
- Replacing & electrifying HVAC systems

- · Upgrading gas appliances to electric
- Installing smoke & CO detectors
- Upgrading window AC units
- Installing free, rooftop solar panels
- Remediating mold and addressing other barriers to weatherization
