Neighborhood Crime Breakdown, July 2025

Reporting Period: 01 June 2025 through 30 June 2025

In June 2025, there was one incident that resulted in a written case report within the Lincoln Park community and one incident that occurred close to the boundary of the Lincoln Park neighborhood, but technically outside of the neighborhood. Both were thefts from autos, but one involved a vehicle left parked outside overnight unlocked.

The Incidents for June 2025 within Lincoln Park were:

5/17/25 – 6/1/25 – Larceny from Auto – 600 Blk. N. Horners La. (250024553)

6/12/25 – 6/13/25 – Larceny from Auto – 300 Blk. Lincoln Ave. (250026375)

In the first incident, reported on 6/1/25 on N. Horners Lane, the victim stated that when she picked up her vehicle from an auto repair shop after being left there for a few weeks, she noticed that an item of personal property that was left inside the vehicle when she dropped it off on 5/17/25 was missing.

In the second incident, reported on 6/13/25 on Lincoln Avenue, the victim stated that he left his vehicle parked overnight unlocked. When he returned, the vehicle was rummaged through and his wallet was missing, which included cash, credit cards, and ID.



There were 23 total calls for service in June 2025, which are summarized in the bar graph below. This was a decrease from June 2024, which had 49 CFS and a decrease from last month, May 2025, which had 31 CFS. Many of the calls involved complaints of domestic disturbances, nuisances, and parking offenses, even community meetings were included in the count of total monthly calls.
